Holiday Parade Rules & Regulations

Entry Deadline & Payment

- Entry form must be submitted by November 24, 2025 at 5 PM.
- No applications will be accepted without payment, and no refunds will be given for any reason.

Assembly & Parade Start

- Parade will begin promptly at 5 PM.
- Any unit not in position will be placed at the end of the parade.

Floats & Display Specifications

- Maximum height limit: 12 feet.
- All decorations and structural materials must be fire-retardant, following local fire marshal standards
- Each float must carry a fully operational fire extinguisher accessible to the driver (ABC type, minimum rating 2-A:10-B:C)

Safety, Conduct & Noise Restrictions

- Throwing or distributing objects (candy, gifts, coupons, etc.) is strictly prohibited. Only walking participants may hand items out carefully, if permitted.
- No live Santas or impersonators are permitted on any float—only the official Parade Santa may appear at the end of the route
- Generators and loud noises are not allowed. “No loud noise or generators” to ensure family-friendly atmosphere.
- No stopping at the judges’ stand; maintain forward motion throughout the route.
- Holiday lights are required on all entries; decorations should be sufficient to illuminate participants and satisfy judging criteria

Participation & Supervision

- All units must complete the entire route—no early exits or partial participation.
- Children under 12 must be always accompanied by an adult.
- Entries must be family-friendly in terms of theme, costume, decorations, and behavior.
